## From the Pastor

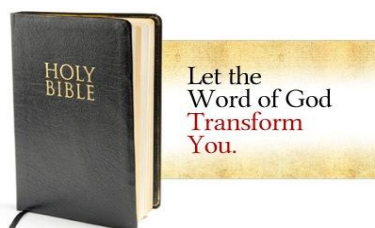


Bayshore Presbyterian Church is mourning the death of
